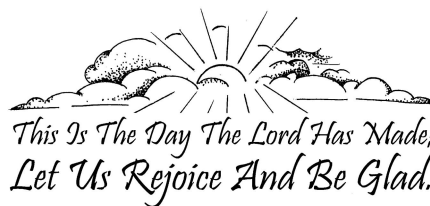

The alternate Gospel reading today, also used as the Gospel reading at the Easter Vigil, is from the original ending of the Gospel of Mark (16:1-8). In this ending there is no account of the women who were at the tomb spreading the message of Jesus' resurrection. They hear it from a young man "clothed in a white robe," and they are enjoined by this man to tell the disciples that the risen Lord will meet them in Galilee. But out of fear "[t]hey said nothing to anyone" (16:8). (This last verse is not included in the passage chosen for proclamation on Easter.)

People are much more accustomed to hearing Gospels-including the Gospel of Mark with its "longer ending" added to it (16:9-20)-end with the announcement of the Resurrection and actual Resurrection appearances.

This is not the only time that Mark writes about fear standing between people and Jesus. When the Gerasenes see that Jesus has healed the man possessed by demons, they are afraid and ask Jesus to depart from them (5:16-17). The power of Jesus is something that overwhelms them, as is the case also with the women at the tomb.

The experience of Jesus' power has overwhelmed others in this Gospel. It is Mark who writes that a leper's announcement of his healing leads people to so throng Jesus as to make it impossible for him to enter towns openly (1:45). Later Mark will structure a large section of his Gospel around three foretellings by Jesus of his passion and death, the consequent inability of his own disciples to understand these sayings and their opting instead for positions of power rather than weakness (8:27 - 10:45).

Perhaps the hold that power in this world has on the human psyche leads people away from the experience of a greater power that operates first through suffering but ultimately through resurrection.

Our Easter Mission "Have no fear. The outcome of the battle for life is already decided, even though the struggle goes on against great odds and with much suffering... "Christ is now raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep ... so in Christ all will come to life again" (1 Cor. 15:20-22). The paradox of the Christian message is this: Christ - the head - has already conquered sin and death. Christ in his body - the pilgrim people of God - continually suffers the onslaught of the Evil One and all the evil which sinful humanity is capable of.
